Discussions to have with others:

DOCTORS

- **Discuss Body boundaries and consent.** It's nice to have an open discussion *in front of our kid(s)* so that they hear what we are sharing with the doctor.

Script idea: "I want to share with you that I am teaching my kid(s) all about their body boundaries and consent. Can you please help me by asking my kid(s) before touching their body and sharing about procedures in detail so that they are informed before touching their body? I want to consider their consent as much as possible. *When we have no choice but to do something for their physical well-being against their consent, I want to take the time to explain this to them as well.* I hope you understand."

DAYCARE TEACHERS

- **Discuss Body boundaries and consent.** It's nice to have an open discussion *in front of our kid(s)* so that they hear what we are sharing with their teacher.

Script idea: "*I want to share with you that I am teaching my kid(s) all about their body boundaries and consent. Can you please help us by asking my kid(s) before touching their body? I hope you can understand the importance of this for us.*"

FAMILY/BABYSITTERS/FRIENDS

- **Discuss Body boundaries and consent.** It's nice to have an open discussion *in front of our kid(s)* so that they hear what we are sharing with others.

Script idea: "We are practicing consent in our home. That means that before we touch someone else's body, we ask for their consent. Before tickling, kissing, or hugging, we need to check in with each other. When someone says "no," we want to honour their boundary. Can I count on you to help us out with this?"

- **Discuss our 'no closed rooms' policy.** Share how in our home we don't play in closed rooms. Doors must be opened and unlocked.
